2023 GTPN Role Model School Visit

On the 30th and 31st of March 2023, five GTPN (Global Tibetan Professional Network) members visited four Tibetan Children's Village (TCV) Schools in Himachal Pradesh, Northern India, for the Annual GTPN Role Model School Visit as a part of the ENVISION's School Outreach Program. The interactive session saw 417 students from classes 10 and 12 students benefit.

The visiting Tibetan Professionals with diverse backgrounds, such as journalists, researchers, illustrators, Human Resources, and Architecture, played an essential role in catalyzing the students to spark discussion on various professions depending on their passion.

The breakout sessions led by the professionals created an inclusive and close environment where each student could put forth their aspirations and questions.

A student from TCV Suja reached out to one of the visiting professionals and shared his dream of becoming a 'Master Chef' and asked for his guidance. It was astonishing to see the student will power to understand and be aware of facing the challenges that lie ahead.



In the closing remark, a student from TCV Upper Dharamsala expressed her joy in meeting and interacting with professionals and learned that an average student could also dream and achieve milestones in life. Another added that she was overwhelmed knowing that a Tibetan Journalist works in mainstream Indian Media.

The Principals of the four participating schools appreciated the program and requested ENVISION to continue it next year.

Participating schools are TCV Suja (upto class X), TCV Gopalpur (upto class XII with Humanity/Arts stream), TCV Chauntra (Upto class X), and TCV Upper Dharamsala (upto Class XII students with Humanity/Arts stream).
